

Remove lake encroachments, adhere to timeline: HC to BBMP

Engineers will be suspended for non-compliance

The Karnataka High Court on Wednesday said the engineers of Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP) will be deemed suspended if they do not adhere to the timeline in removing encroachments in Subramanyapura and Begur lakes. A division bench headed by Acting Chief Justice Alok

of the area within short time and also to issue notices to the encroachers. The bench directed the authorities to start removing the encroachments

in a time-bound manner.

Permit for walkway
Meanwhile, the court permitted the construction of a walkway around the Begur Lake. However, the bench said the authorities shall use only the de-silted material of the lake for the construction without compromising the actual area of the lake.

The court has also directed that the walkway constructed should strictly be used for maintenance of the lake, de-silting and de-weeding purposes. It has also specified that the existing roads falling within the lake area of both Subramanyapura and Begur lakes should not be widened.

Chinese firm to manufacture 216 metro coaches

Will partner with Titagarh Wagons in Kolkata

The Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation Ltd (BMRC) has accepted China-based CRRC's request to manufacture a total of 216 metro train coaches in partnership with Titagarh Wagons in Kolkata.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed on Friday puts an end to the uncertainty over the supply of coaches that is behind schedule at least by two years. The BMRC, however, declined the CRRC's request to increase the price. Confirming the development, Anjum Parwez, Managing Director, BMRC, said the MoU had been signed and added that the project cost would remain the same.



to float a fresh tender for these many coaches had the Chinese firm not agreed to supply coaches as per the 2019 prices quoted by the company.

Early this year, the BMRC had threatened to scrap the bank guarantee and scrap the contract with CRRC's subsidiary CRRC Nanjing Puzhen Co Ltd after the company, which won a Rs 1,578-crore contract in 2019, failed to set up a manufacturing plant in India. CRRC, however, approached the high court and sought more time to implement the project by citing revised Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) norms. The court had directed the BMRC to review CRRC's fresh proposal.

In a major development, M S Ramaiah University of Applied Sciences (MSRUAS), under Gokula Education Foundation (Medical), signed a memorandum of understanding with Indian Technology Congress Association (ITCA) on Tuesday July 19, 2022, to develop and build a student satellite - Ramaiah Sat - coinciding with the Azadi Ki Amrit Mahotsav - 75 years of Indian Independence. MSRUAS will build the student satellite, monitored by Indian Space Research Organization, and with the help of ITCA which is the nodal agency to build 75 Student Satellite Mission. This ambitious project was announced by Prime Minister Narendra Modi during his address to the world leaders at the 76th United Nations General Assembly.

According to the MoU, MSRUAS will build Ramaiah Sat in cooperation with the international space exploration agencies CSPI, Serbia World Can Sat Rocketry Championship (WCRC), ITCA-TSC will support with satellite education, training, and multi-disciplinary research and development projects related to the new space era, nano satellites, ground stations and initiatives focused on student satellite development. The ITCA/TSC supported Ground Control Station (GCS) will be established at the MSRUAS campus to monitor Ramaiah Sat. The cost of Ramaiah Sat is Rs 1 crore.

In this mission, students can build their own satellites and launch them with the support of ISRO. Ramaiah Sat will have a payload of 300 grams. It is a 1.60 kg class satellite with a 10' payload to monitor other satellites. ISRO will launch the satellite with UHF and VHF links with a satellite ground station at MSRUAS, Peenya campus. The satellite mission's functional attributes are water quality monitoring, providing wireless communication network in remote areas, passive radar for weather monitoring and fisherman SOS.

Kannada version of agri-tech app to benefit state farmers

BENGALURU, DHNS: Indian-made agri-tech app, BigHaat, on Wednesday launched its Kannada version for the benefit of farmers from Karnataka.

BigHaat is an Indian agri-tech startup providing end-to-end solutions for the agricultural community and its allies. The Kannada version of the app was launched by Shivayogi C Kalasad, secretary, Agriculture Department, Bengaluru.

Sateesh Nukala, CEO & co-founder, BigHaat, said, "Haat is a marketplace. The space is like an emotion to the farmer. Since this is a big marketplace, not just for selling produce, everything the farmer would need can be

availed here, including services. That's how we named it 'BigHaat'."

"There were two options, one was to provide a platform in pre-harvest and the other in post-harvest. There were a handful of startups in 2015 and they were trying for technology intervention in order to take the produce to the market. I wanted to create a sustainable impact, by traveling with the farmer through the crop cycle," he said.

The pre-harvest problem was a complex one. "That's how we started developing the marketplace platform, wherein we wanted to address all the quality inputs for it, across the categories and according to convenience."
